



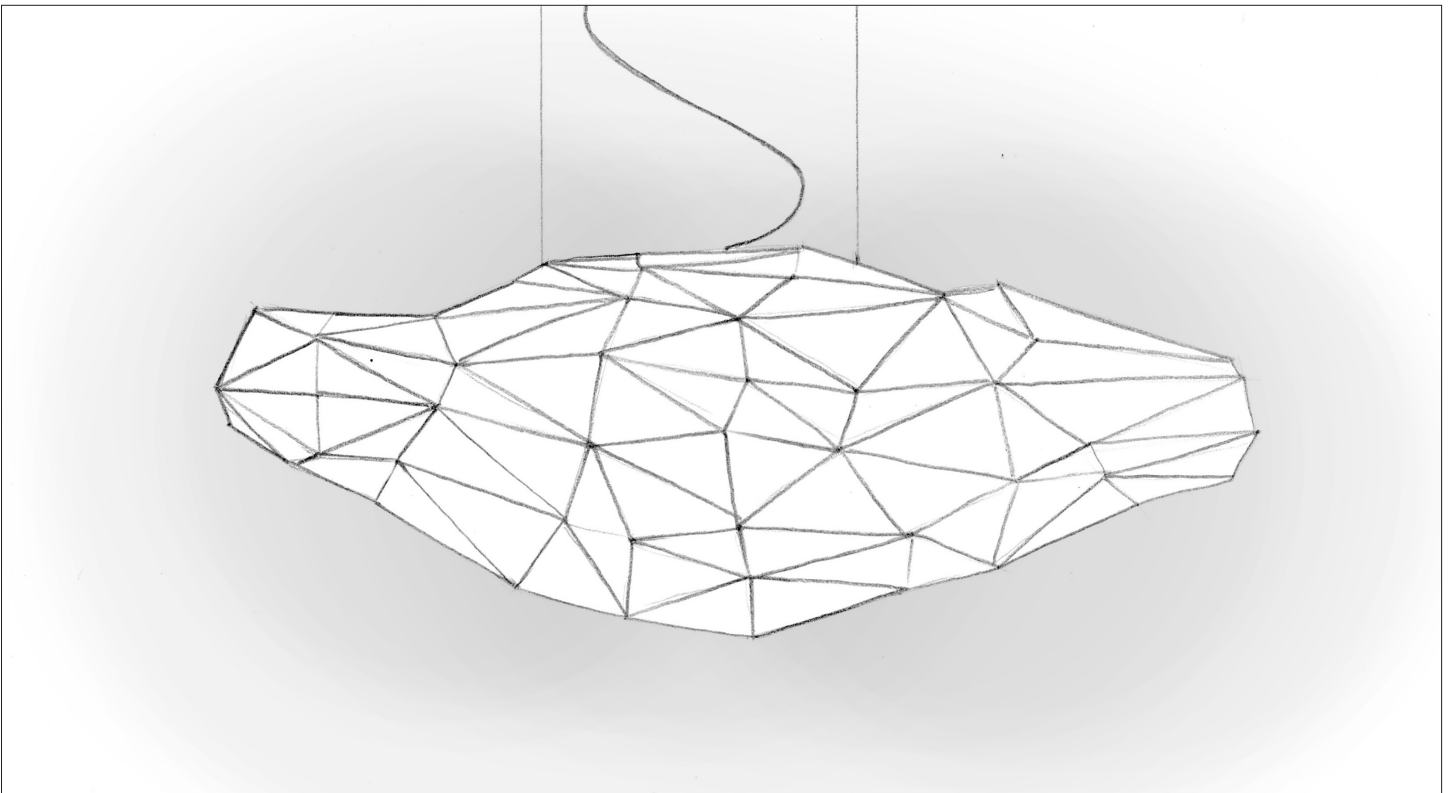
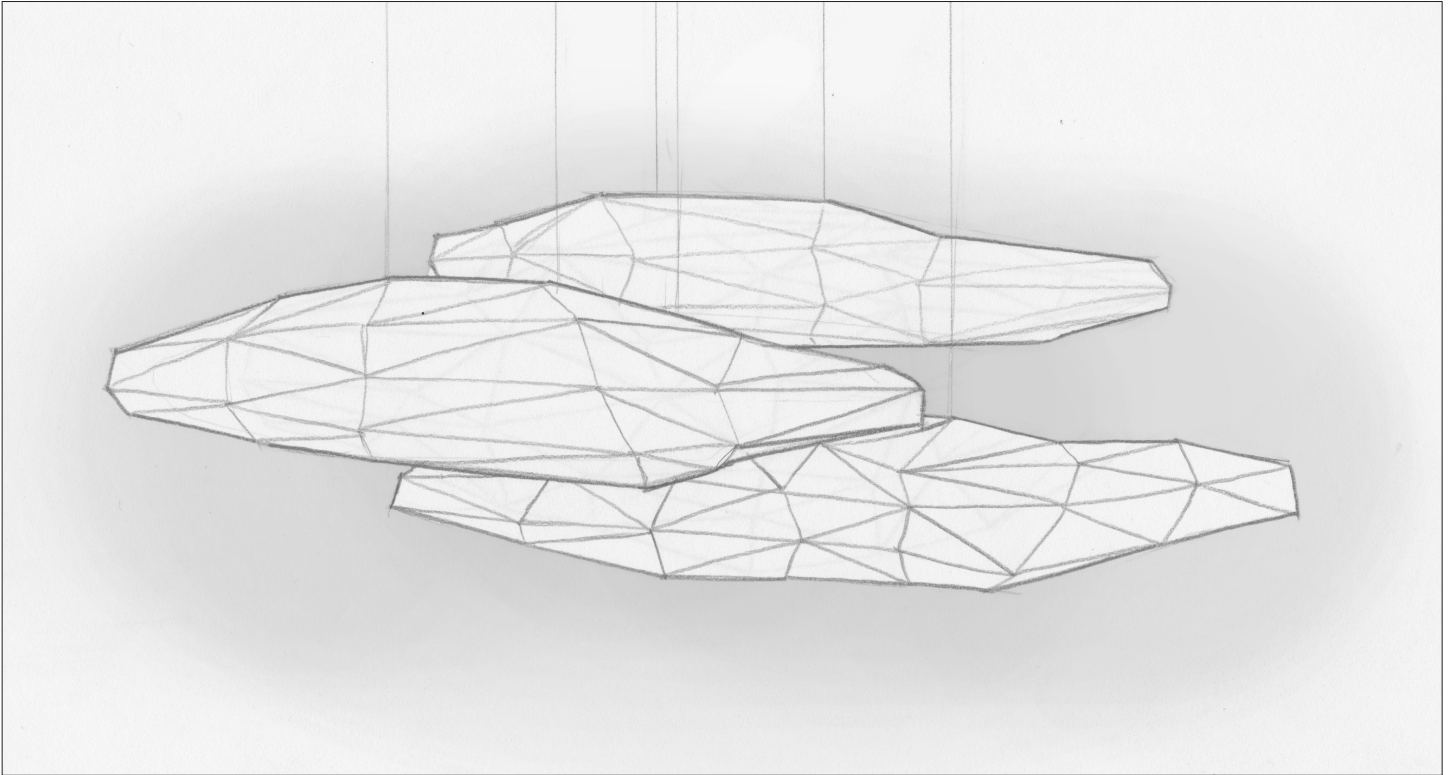
RBS WEBCOAT LAMP

Utilizing a unique material from the 1940's, initially sourced by George Nelson for his classic bubble lamps, the material resembles paper or fiber, but is in fact a sprayed PVC material that creates a cocoon like membrane around a steel wire frame. Now incorporating this process with other techniques unique to the studio, Webcoat lamps can be adapted on a commission basis to produce sculptural chandeliers, pushing the boundaries of scale to explore irregular forms for site specific installations.

Material: Steel and polymer web-coat.
